

ALUMNI FEEDBACK REPORT

(ACADEMIC YEAR 2015-16)

This is a presentation of the alumni feedback of academic year 2015-16. Every year at the end of the second session feedback committee through its Alumni feedback in charge organizes feedback. The main parameters covered in the questionnaire for Alumni feedback are focused on student **concerned things**. The **parameters** are Admission procedure, Fee structure, Environment, Infrastructure and laboratory facilities, Faculty, project guidance, support services, Library, Training and placement, canteen, Hostel facilities, alumni Association, How do you rate the learning experience, How do you rate the courses that you have learnt in relation to your job and overall rating. These **parameters** are rated on the scale of 1-5 i.e. Poor (1), Average (2), Good (3), very good (4), Excellent (5). The Frequency is taken as 25 alumni and feedback is obtained.

For academic year 2015-16 the feedback of alumni is taken and analysis is made on the basis of following tables obtained from feedback forms. 24% of the alumni rated **Admission procedure** organized as excellent, 68% alumni rated it as very good, 8% as good. The **Fee structure** grievances were rated as excellent by 16%, very good by 56%, good by 20% and average by 8% alumni. The alumni rated the **Environment** as 12% alumni felt it as excellent, 56% very good, 32% good. The **Infrastructure and Lab Facilities** was rated as excellent by 44% alumni, 52% very good, 4% good. 48% alumni felt the **Faculty** as excellent, 52% very good. The **project Guidance** grievances were rated as excellent by 16%, very good by 56%, good by 20% and average by 8% alumni. The alumni rated the **Support services** as 4% alumni felt it as excellent, 64% very good, 24% good and 8% as average. The **Training and placement** was rated as Excellent 12%, very good by 48% alumni, 20% good, average 12% and 8% poor. Most of the alumni (60%) rated **Library** organized as excellent, 36% alumni rated it as very good, 4% as average. The alumni rated the **Canteen** as 12% alumni felt it was very good, 32% good, 28% good, 40% as average and 16% as Poor. The **Hostel facility** was rated as very good by 8% alumni, 16% average, and 76% poor. About **Alumni association** alumni rated as 12% excellent, 68% very good, and 12% good, 4% average and 4% rated as poor. The **How do you rate the learning experience** was rated as excellent by 12% alumni, 88% very good. **How do you rate the courses that you have learnt in relation to your job** received ratings as excellent by 8%, very good 76%, good 12%, and average 4% and **Overall rating** of the college rated as 8% alumni gave excellent, 76% very good, 8% good, 4% average and 4% poor.

Good Responses:

The Alumni happy with admission procedure (68% very good), Alumni are also very happy with Faculty of the college and shows their very good rating for training and placement. They show their experiences and availability of books through the Excellent (60%) rating for Library. Most of the alumni shows their very good learning experience and their courses were relevant with their jobs. They recollect the friendly teachers and homely atmosphere of the college. They miss the college days, activities and sports events. The overall rating of the college is very good.


Suggestions to college/IQAC:

The following suggestions can be deduced from the analysis of alumni feedback for the "actions to be taken"

1. Most of the alumni are not happy with fee structure of the college but it is governed by the university and state govt. The infrastructure and Laboratory facilities rated Excellent and Very good and this is due to continuous attention by the college and suggestions through feedback committee. The administration of college should take some action in connection with support services, training and placement and academic environment. Campus should have WI-FI connectivity
2. For this session (2014-15) feedback alumni think that the support services should be increases and there is need to activate support services department.
3. There is canteen in college campus but there is urgent need to improve the canteen.
4. The hostel facility is not available in campus hence the rating regarding the hostel is to be neglected.
5. 88% alumni rated learning experiences are very good. For excellent rating teachers have to include modern teaching aids in teaching. They should start preparing power point presentation and other innovative teaching aids to stimulate the students for better understanding. **The college administration is further hereby suggested to make the arrangements of digital and ICT equipped classrooms since present facilities do not fulfill the needs on the basis of strength of students.**

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
